WALBEOFF, Elizabeth, William, John, Mary



Inscription

In memory of Elizabeth 2nd wife of John Walbeoff of this parish who died February 5th 1838 aged 43 years.

Side 2 In memory of William son of John and Elizabeth Walbeoff of this parish who died March 1849 aged 20 years.

Side 3 To the memory of John son of John and Mary Walbeoff of this parish who died in his infancy March 9th 1812. Also Mary wife of John Walbeoff who died March 1816 aged 33 years.

On the 25th January 1818, John Walbeoff married Elizabeth Thomas in Cwmyoy. Their first recorded child, William, was baptized in Llanelly on 22nd February 1829 by Curate J Bowen. Subsequently, Frederick was baptized on 2nd June 1831 by Officiating Minister Thomas Marsdon, and Anne was baptized on 7th January 1838 by the Curate J Price.

John Walbeoff's first wife, Mary, was buried on 29th March 1816 by Curate D Edwards. Elizabeth, his second wife, died on 5th February 1838 from fever. Their son William passed away on 1st March 1849, succumbing to Phthisis (tuberculosis).

The 1841 Wales Census shows the Walbeoff family residing in Dan-y-Lan, Llanelly Parish, Breconshire. John, then 60 years old, worked as a labourer. His household included his sons John (20) and Lewis (15), daughters Christina (7) and Anne (3), and son Frederick (11).

By the 1851 Wales Census, the family was living at Harewell Rock in the same parish. John was now 70 and still working as a labourer. His sons Lewis (26) and Frederick (20) were present, with Lewis working as an Iron Puddler, his daughter Christina was 18 years old.
