1795 BIRTH RECORD. Peterchurch, Herefordshire.
28th June Samuel Hughes baptised.

1835 MARRIAGE RECORD. St Margarets, Herefordshire, England.
8th October. Samuel Hughes aged 40 years marries Catherine Maddy of Dorstone aged 28 years.

1841 Census of England living at Brook House, St Margarets, Herefordshire.
Samuel Hughes aged 46 years occupation Farmer and enumerator of the census with wife Catherine aged 34 years. Also present John Hughes aged 80 years, probably his father and Catherine's son Edwin Maddy.

1847 DEATH RECORD. Weobley, Oct Nov Dec Vol26 Page168.
Death of Catherine Hughes.

1849 MARRIAGE RECORD. St Margarets Parish Church, Herefordshire.
18th February. Samuel Hughes of full age, widower, occupation Farmer, father John Hughes also a Farmer marries Elizabeth Lea of full age, spinster, occupation servant, father Robert Lea a labourer.

1851 Census of Wales living at Pantatilla [Pant-y-tyle], Llanvihangel Crucorney, Monmouthshire.
Samuel Hughes aged 50 years, Farmer of 60 acres with wife Elizabeth aged 25 years of Brilley, Herefordshire with daughters Sarah aged 2 years and Elizabeth aged 2 months. They also have a lodger.

1861 Census of Wales living near Ty Isaf, Maesygwartha, Llanelly.
Samuel Hughes aged 65 years now a farm labourer with wife Elizabeth aged 33 years with daughters Elizabeth aged 10 years and Margaret aged 7 years.

1871 Census of Wales living at Ysgubor Edmund, Llanelly.
Samuel Hughes aged 74 years a labourer with wife Elizabeth aged 43 years, a laundress with daughters Margaret aged 18, Emma aged 5, Hannah aged 2 [see photograph], Sarah [Taylor] a widow and her son Samuel aged 4. Also present an infant Ann Davies Pritchard aged 8 months.

1872 DEATH RECORD. Death Certificate.
12th January Death of Samuel Hughes aged 74 years of Ysgubor Edmund from chronic asthma and the dropsy. Daughter Sarah Taylor was present at his death. He was buried at St Elli's on the 15th.
