1847 BIRTH RECORD Ullingswick, Herefordshire. [Bromyard Herefordshire Jul Aug Sep Vol 26 Page 159]

William Bergett Matthews born parents Josiah Matthews farmer of Bredwardine, Herefordshire and Mary Ann Crump of Bodenham, Herefordshire.

1851 BIRTH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

6th July Emily Bush of Brynmawr [Llangattock] baptised parents George a butcher from Buckland, Somerset and Mary nee Chilton [E 143] daughter of Solomon Chilton of Nantyglo Monmouthshire.

1851 England Census living in Bowrey Lane, Hereford.

William Matthews aged 3 years with Parents Josiah 33 a farmer who is out of business, and Mary A 47, and siblings Matilda 12, Richard 11, Arthur 9, Edmund 8 all at school and Enoch aged 2 years.

1861 Wales Census living at Hereford House, Bailey Street, Brynmawr, Breconshire.

William Matthews aged 13 years at school with parents Josiah 42 a beer house keeper of Bredwardine, Herefordshire and Mary A 45 of Bodenham, Herefordshire and siblings Richard 21, Arthur 19, Edmund 17, all puddlers, William 13 and Amelia aged 8 years both at school.

1871 Wales Census living at Lower Common Farm, Gilwern, Llanelly.

William Matthews aged 33?? a butcher and farmer of 39 acres with mother Mary Ann 57 an annuitant and brother Arthur 28 a farm bailiff and sister Amelia 18 a dairymaid. Also present William J aged 2 years.

1871 Wales Census living at the Butcher's shop, Beaufort Street, Brynmawr, Breconshire.

Emily Bush aged 19 years with parents George 51 a butcher with wife Mary 37 and siblings Sarah Ann 21, Elizabeth 13, Anne 7, and May aged 5 years.

1875 MARRIAGE RECORD [Crickhowell Apr May Jun Vol 11b Page 179.]

William Matthews marries Emily Bush of Llangattock Breconshire.

1881 Wales Census living at Common Farm, Llanelly.

William Matthews aged 31 farmer employing 2 men with wife Emily 28. Also present is George Bush 61 an out of work farmer of Buckland Somerset with children Lucy 15 a servant, George 13, and Albert aged 11 both at school.

1901 Wales Census living at Fynnon Farm, Glaslyn Court, Llanelly.

William Matthews aged 52 a farmer with wife Emily aged 50 years.

1911 Wales Census living at Prospect House, Gilwern. Breconshire.

William Burget Matthews 64 an egg merchant on his own account assisted by his wife Emily aged 61. They have been married for 37 years but have had no children.

1916 DEATH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

12th April death of Emily Matthews of Gilwern aged 64 years and was buried on the 15th [E L Jones Curate.]

1919 DEATH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

11th February death of William Burgot Matthews of Prospect House Gilwern aged 72 years and was buried on the 13th [David Williams Curate.]
