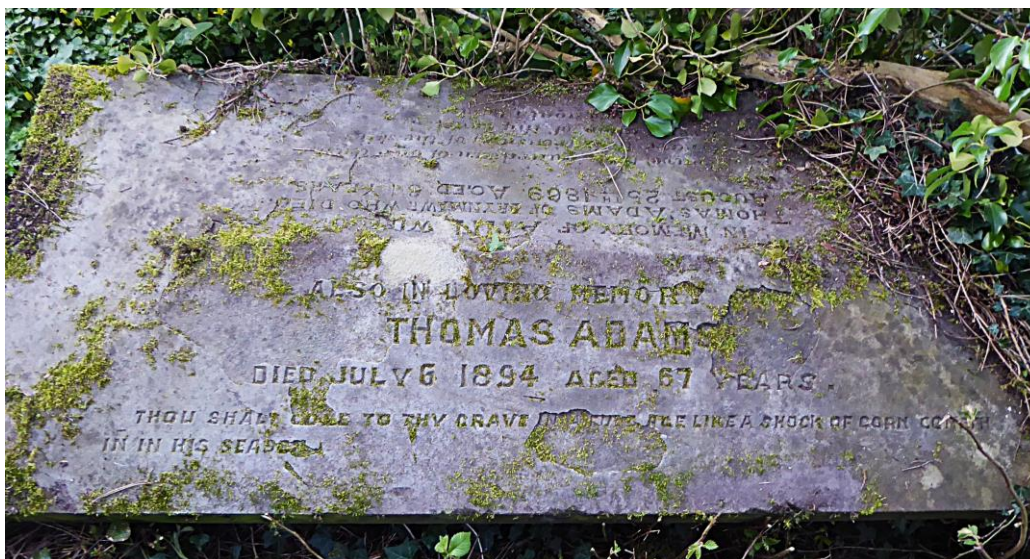


GRAVE NO: E36A

ADAMS, Ann & Thomas



Inscription:

In Memory of ANN wife of
THOMAS ADAMS of Brynmawr who died August 25th 1869 aged 34 years
'Verse.'

Also in Loving Memory of
THOMAS ADAMS
Died July 6th 1894 aged 67 years
'Thou shalt come to thy grave in a full age like a shock of corn cometh in in his season.'

1859 MARRIAGE RECORD Abergavenny Apr May Jun Vol 11a Page 176.

Possible marriage between Thomas Adams and Ann Winstone.

1861 Wales Census living in Aberystroth, Monmouthshire.

Thomas Adams aged 34 of Aberystroth [Nantyglo] an agent in an iron works with wife Ann 25 of Llanelly with son Thomas aged 1 years born In Aberystroth [Nantyglo].

1869 DEATH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

25th August Ann Adams of Brynmawr dies aged 34 years and is buried on the 28th [J P Alban Curate.]

1871 Wales Census living in Bailey Street, Brynmawr.

Thomas Adams aged 44 a widower and agent with son Thomas 11 and daughter Elizabeth aged 8 years both at school. Also Mary Ann Perry a house servant.

1881 Wales Census living at 65-66 Kings Street, Brynmawr.

Thomas Adams aged 54 a widower and coal agent with son Thomas 21 on railway service and daughter Elizabeth 19 a scholar.

1884 MARRIAGE RECORD Coedkernow Parish Church, Newport, Monmouthshire.

14th July Thomas Adams aged 57 years a widower and coal merchant of Brynmawr, father Thomas a farmer marries by license Mary Lewis aged 53 a spinster and dressmaker of Coedkernow, father Thomas Lewis a farmer.

1891 Wales Census living at 66 King Street, Brynmawr.

Thomas Adams aged 64 years a coal merchant now married to Mary aged 60 years.

1894 DEATH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

6th July Thomas Adams of Tredegar dies aged 69 years and was buried on the 11th [David Price Curate.]
