CORDY, Elias & Clara



Inscription:

To the Memory of ELIAS CORDY of this Parish who died April 19th 1856 aged 48 years.

*'Farewell dear wife my life is past,
My love for you so long did last,
But after me no sorrow take,
But love my children for my sake.'*

1807 BIRTH RECORD Parish of Berkeley, Gloucestershire [Christening Records.]

18th January Elias Cordy son of Samuel Cordy cordwainer.

1841 MARRIAGE RECORD Llanelly Parish Church.

25th December Elias Cordy of full age, a haulier of Llanelly Common father Samuel Cordy a cordwainer marries Ann Cordy of full age a spinster of Llanelly Common, father John Cordy a weaver signed with their mark and witnessed by John Cordy and Henry Williams [J Hughes Curate.]

1846 BIRTH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

28th June Clara Cordy of Llanelly Common baptised, father Elias a greengrocer and Ann Cordy. [J Hughes Curate.]

1851 Wales Census living in Llanelly Common, Llanelly, Breconshire.

Elias Cordy aged 44 years a gardener? From Berkeley, Gloucestershire with wife Ann aged 36 from Cam, Gloucestershire and children Clara aged 5 and Elizabeth aged 1 years.

1856 DEATH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

19th April Elias Cordy of Llanelly Common dies aged 49 years and is buried on the 27th [Arthur Griffiths Incumbent.]

1856 DEATH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

1st May Clara Cordy of Llanelly Common dies aged 9 years and is buried on the 5th [Arthur Griffiths Incumbent.]

Ann Cordy then marries John Morgan a nail maker from Merthyr Tydful and can be found living in Lower Common in 1861 with her daughter Elizabeth aged 11. In 1870, John Morgan aged 44, his wife Ann [nee Cordy] 46 and daughter Elizabeth aged 20, arrive in New York on the 11th April on board the SS Nevada from Liverpool. Elizabeth marries William Price an engineer. The family can be found in the 1880 United States census living in the township of Allen, Northampton, Pennsylvania, William and Elizabeth Price together with Ann [Cordy] and John Morgan.

Ann Morgan nee Cordy dies in Catasaqua, Allentown, Pennsylvania In 1882.
