1851 BIRTH RECORD Kilpeck, Hereford, England [England select births.]

27th April Esther Deborah William baptised parents James and Caroline Williams.

1861 Wales Census living at the Five Bells Inn, Maesygartha, Llanelly.

Esther Deborah Williams aged 9 with parents James 43 Innkeeper of Glasbury Herefordshire and Caroline 41 of Clodock, Herefordshire and siblings James 7, Caroline 3 and Mary aged 1 year [E6B]. Also a house servant Margaret Meredith aged 16.

1863 BIRTH RECORD Walton in Gordano, Somerset [Bedminster Apr May Jun Vol 5c Page 841]

Birth of Albert Edward Plumley, parents Thomas of Walton in Gordano and Emma of Clevedon.

1871 Census of England living in Walton Street, Walton in Gordano, near Clevedon Somerset.

Albert E Plumley aged 8 at school with Parents Thomas 48 a ship hand of Walton and Emma 47 of Clevedon, and siblings Ada 5, Amy 3, and Arthur aged 1 year. Also present Jane a niece.

1871 Wales Census living at 3 Steel Works Terrace, Ebbw Vale, Monmouthshire.

Esther D Williams aged 19 with father James now a widower and a railman with siblings James 17, Mary 11 [E6B], and John aged 9 years. Also two lodgers.

1881 Wales Census living at The Gaer, Newport, St Woollos.

Esther D Williams aged 29 working as a parlour maid in the household of Daniel Whitehouse of Worcester an iron and tinplate manufacturer and JP.

1891 MARRIAGE RECORD Holy Trinity Church, Nantyglo, Monmouthshire.

20th January Albert Edward Plumley 32?, Bachelor, labourer of Nantyglo, father Thomas Plumley labourer marries Esther Deborah Williams 36?, spinster of Nantyglo father James Williams labourer.

1891 Wales Census living at the Drysiog Inn, Ebbw Vale. Monmouthshire.

Albert Edward Plumley aged 23 a labourer with wife Esther 33 and father in law James Williams aged 75 Innkeeper from Glasbury.

1901 Wales Census living at the Drysiog Inn, Ebbw Vale, Monmouthshire.

Albert Plumley 38, Tavern keeper on his own account with wife Esther 49 and his brother Arthur aged 30 a fireman at boiler?

1907 DEATH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records & Index of wills.]

20th October Albert Edward Plumley of the Drysiog Inn, Ebbw Vale dies probate to Esther Deborah Plumley his widow. Buried on the 28th aged 48 years. [D Williams vicar of Ebbw Vale]

1911 Wales Census living at the Drysiog Inn, Ebbw Vale, Monmouthshire.

Esther Deborah Plumley aged 59 now a widow sister in law and assisting the publican Robert Henry Trotman 56 [E6B] and his wife Mary [Williams E6B]. Also Charles Henry Trotman aged 14 years at school. She had been married for 17 years but had no children.

1921 Wales Census living at Drysiog Inn Ebbw Vale, Monmouthshire.

Esther Deborah Plumley aged 70 years 3 months and 7 days, widow and house keeper with Robert Henry Trotman aged 69 widower, licensed victualler and beer retailer on his own account and his son Charles Henry Trotman aged 24 a steel worker for the Ebbw Vale Company out of work!

1921 DEATH RECORDS St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records & Index of wills.]

24th June Esther Deborah Plumley of the Drysiog Inn Ebbw Vale dies. Probate to Charles Henry Trotman Steel worker. Buried on June 28th aged 70 years [J Jones curate and R Hughes curate of Ebbw Vale.]
