DAVIES, William & Albert, Solomon, Margaret, William Jnr



Inscription:

In loving memory of WILLIAM DAVIES, of Gellyfellen, who died 11th November 1889 aged 47. And of ALBERT, son of WILLIAM & RACHEL DAVIES, died 4th July 1880 aged 16 months.

Also SOLOMON, their son, who was killed by the lamentable accident at Tylerstown, 27th January 1896 aged 25.

In the midst of life we are in death.

Also, Margaret Davies, daughter of the above, who died April 4th 1901 aged 16 years.

Also William Davies, son of the above, who died June 24th 1918 aged 52 years.

1871 Wales Census living at Gellyfellen

William, aged 29 mine coal haulier, Head. Rachel aged 28 wife. Thomas aged 10, Daniel aged 8, William aged 6, Martha aged 3, and Solomon aged 5 months

1881 Wales Census living at Gellyfellen

William aged 38 Haulier, Head. Rachel aged 38, Housekeeper. Thomas aged 20, Daniel aged 18 and William aged 15 all coal miners. Martha, aged 12, Solomon aged 10, Sarah J aged 6, Benjamin aged 3 and John aged 4 months.

1891 Wales Census living at Gellyfellen

Rachel Davies aged 48 Head (widow). William aged 25, Solomon aged 20, Benjamin aged 18 all coal miners. Sarah Jane aged 16 (domestic servant), John aged 10, Rachel Ann aged 8 & Margaret aged 6.

1901 Wales Census living at Gellyfellen

Rachel aged 58 Head (widow). William aged 34, Benjamin aged 23, and John aged 20, all single and coal hewers. Rachel Ann aged 18 Domestic (at home), Maggie aged 16 Dressmaker (own a/e?)

William died 11th November 1889 and was buried on 16th November 1889 at St Elli Church. Curate of Nantyglo: J B Timothy

Albert Davies, Llanelly Hill, Page 12

Albert died 4th July 1880 and was buried 20th July at St Elli Church. Curate: J. Davies

Solomon Davies, Gellyfellen, Page 171

Solomon died 27th January 1896 and was buried on Feb 3rd 1896 at St Elli Church. Curate: David Price

William died June 24th 1918 and was buried on June 29th at St Elli Church. Curate: David Williams
