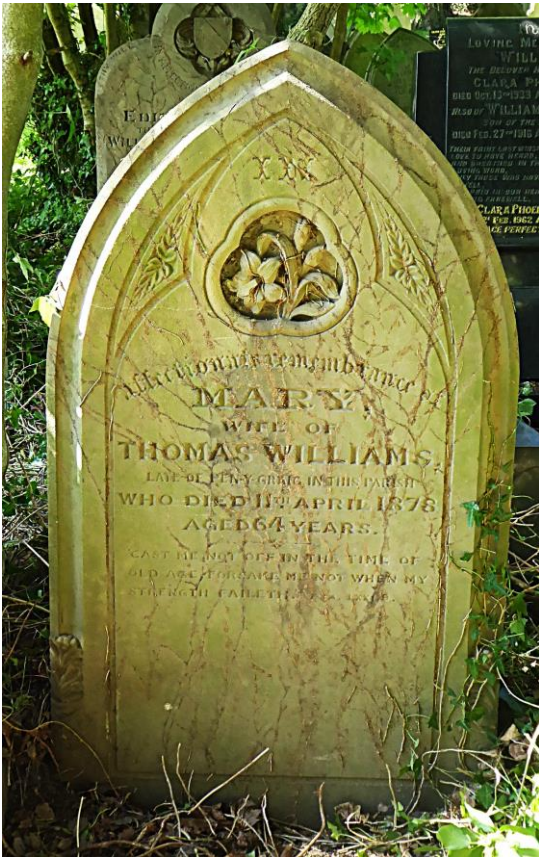


GRAVE No: F149
WILLIAMS, Mary



Inscription:

Affectionate Remembrance of
MARY
Wife of
THOMAS WILLIAMS
Late of Pen-y-Graig of this parish
Who died 11th April 1878 aged 64 years.

*'Cast me not off in the time of old age,
Forsake me not when my strength faileth.'*

Psalm 71:9

There is evidence to suggest that a Thomas and Mary Williams lived at Pen-y-Graig farm in 1861. The 'late of' may suggest that Mary lived there and together with her age and date of birth, the research is based solely on this evidence.

1861 Census of Wales living at Pen-y-Graig, Llanelly.

Mary Williams aged 48 years farmer's wife of Grwyney Fawr [Cwmyoy], Breconshire with husband Thomas aged 63 years farming 32 acres of Cwmyoy, Monmouthshire with son Thomas aged 25, unmarried farmer's son also of Cwmyoy.

1871 Census of Wales living at Duffryn Clydach, Gilwern.

Mary Williams aged 58 years with husband Thomas aged 72 years now a farm labourer. Another unknown occupant is absent.

1878 DEATH RECORD St Elli [Llanelly Parish Records.]

11th April Mary Williams of Gilwern dies aged 65 years and was buried on the 15th.

1881 Census of Wales living at Duffryn Cottage, Gilwern.

Thomas Williams aged 81 years now a widower and agricultural labourer with his niece Anne Griffiths aged 23 a general servant from Cwmyoy.
