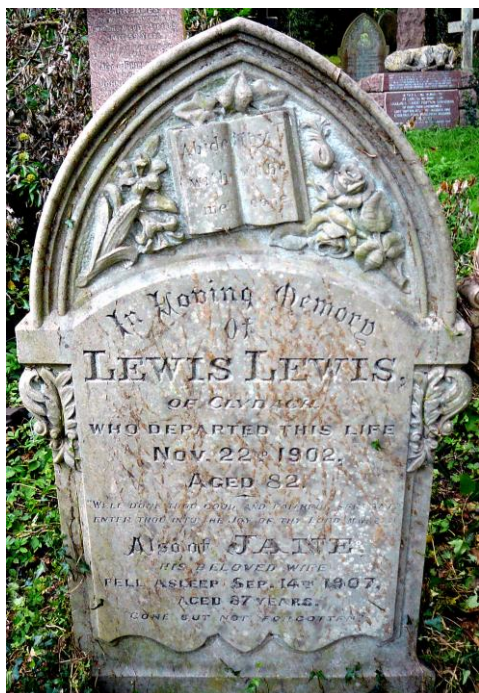

Inscription:

In Loving Memory
of
LEWIS LEWIS
of Clydach
who departed this life
Nov 22nd 1902

*Well done thou good and faithful servant
Enter thou into the joy of thy Lord.*

Also JANE
his beloved wife
who fell asleep Sep 14th 1907
aged 87 years.
Gone but not forgotten.

1822 BIRTH RECORD

Baptised 29th July 1822 in Cwmyoy Monmouthshire son of James, Shepherd of Blaencwm and Blanche Lewis.

1853 MARRIAGE RECORD

January 25th aged 31 years, bachelor and labourer of Brynmawr, father James Lewis Labourer to Jane Price aged 30 years, spinster and dressmaker of Brynmawr, father Richard Price, shoemaker of upper Cwmyoy.

1861 Wales Census living at the 'Half Moon' Llanthony.

Lewis Lewis, aged 40 years, a victualler, living with wife Jane and daughter Jane aged 6 months. Also present visitor Eli Perks.

1871 Wales Census living at the 'Rock and Fountain', Cheltenham, Clydach.

Lewis Lewis aged 50 years with wife Jane and family. Also present Richard Price his father in law aged 80 years.

1881 Wales Census living at the 'Rock and Fountain', Clydach.

Lewis Lewis aged 60 years living with wife Jane and family including a lodger a Richard Price aged 70 years a shoemaker from Cwmyoy.

1891 Wales Census living on Main Road [Rock and Fountain?], Clydach.

Lewis Lewis aged 70 years living with wife Jane and two grandchildren Elizabeth and Maud Carpenter.

1901 Wales Census living at the 'Rock and Fountain', Clydach.

Lewis Lewis aged 80 years, Innkeeper, with wife Jane and granddaughter Maud Carpenter.

1902 DEATH RECORD

Lewis Lewis, Inn keeper of the Rock and Fountain dies on the 22nd November.

1907 DEATH RECORD

Jane Lewis dies on September 14th 1907.
