

**GRAVE NO: F328 [Fallen obelisk is by the grave.] Related to F326
JAMES, Lewis & Children**



Inscription:

In Fond Remembrance of The beloved Children of
LEWIS AND JANE JAMES of Brynmawr.
BENJAMIN HAVARD died Dec 1st 1876 aged 5 weeks.
HORACE LEWIS died Sep 2nd 1879 aged 4 1/2 years. And
OSCAR EWART died April 12th 1882 aged 8 months.
Also the above LEWIS JAMES died Sept 30th 1912 aged 72.
Also Of EDGAR HAVARD JAMES
died Feb 26th 1910 aged 26.



1851 Census of Wales. Lewis James living at Ty Uchaf, Maesygartha [above F326].

Lewis James born 1842, father James James a farmer aged 51 years farming 60 acres, and mother Rachel aged 45 years. Siblings include Philip aged 7 [F326], Joshua aged 14 and George aged 15 and like Lewis all destined to be Grocers.

1861 Census of Wales. Living at Coal Brook Vale, Aberystruth. [F326]

Lewis aged 19 years working as a grocer's assistant with brother Philip for Thomas Philips Grocer.

1866 MARRIAGE RECORD. {Crickhowell, Apr May June, vol 11b page 231.}

Lewis James marries Jane Harvard of Llanfrynach.

1875 BIRTH RECORD. {Crickhowell, Jan Feb Mar, vol 11b page 135}

Horace Lewis James, son of Lewis and Jane James born in March.

1876 BIRTH AND DEATH RECORDS. Llanelly Church. [Rector Arthur Griffiths].

Benjamin Havard Lewis son of Lewis and Jane James of Brynmawr born Oct 27th, dies December 1st aged 5 weeks and is buried on December 6th.

1879 DEATH RECORD. Llanelly Church. [Curate John Davies]

2nd September Horace Lewis James of Brynmawr dies aged 4 years & 6 months. Buried on the 6th.

1881 Census of Wales. Living at Blewett House, Blewett Square, Brynmawr.

Lewis James aged 39 years a Grocer employing 3 assistants and 2 servants with wife Jane and 4 offspring.

1881-82 BIRTH AND DEATH RECORDS. Crickhowell Jul Aug Sep vol 11b page 87.

Oscar Ewart James son of Lewis and Jane James born Sept 1881 dies April 12th 1882 aged 8 months.

1901 Census of Wales living at Essendine House, King's Street, Brynmawr.

Lewis James aged 59 years, now a retired Grocer with Jane and 4 offspring including son Edgar aged 17 years, a Drapers Assistant.

1910 DEATH RECORD. Llanelly Church. [Rector George Roberts].

February 26th Edgar Havard Lewis of Carlton House, Abergavenny, dies and is buried on March 2nd..

1911 Census of Wales living at Carlton House, Avenue Road, Abergavenny.

Lewis James aged 69 years living off his own means with wife Jane and 3 offspring. They have been married for 44 years, had 12 children 4 of whom, above, have died.

1912 DEATH RECORD. England and Wales Index of Wills.

September 30th Lewis James dies aged 72 years at Carlton House, Avenue Road, Abergavenny.
