Inscription:

1866 MARRIAGE RECORD Parish of Llanfoist.

5th August Philip Watkins aged 39 a widower and carpenter of Blaenavon father Edward a tailor, married Ann Evans aged 30, a spinster of Blaenavon father William a miner.

1877 BIRTH RECORDS {Crickhowell Jan Feb Mar Vol 11b Page 133}

Martha Ann Watkins born and baptised in the Parish of Llanelly on the 18th of March, Parents Philip and Ann Watkins of Blackrock. Mother Ann Watkins died on the 11th March 1877, 7 days prior to the baptism.

1871 Wales Census living in Blackrock village.

Philip Watkins, aged 43, a carpenter born in Nantyglo with wife Ann aged 34 born in Abergavenny, with Edward Watkins, son aged 13, Margaret Watkins, aged 10, Gwenllian Watkins, daughter aged 9 all at school and Leah Augusta Watkins, daughter aged 2 (*only Leah Augusta Watkins is the daughter of Philip and Ann, other children from previous marriage to Mary Price*)

1877 DEATH RECORDS Llanelly Parish Records {Crickhowell Jan Feb Mar Vol 11b Page 97}

11th March Ann Watkins died aged 40 and was buried at St Elli Church on the 15th.

1881 Wales Census living in Ebbw Vale

John Williams, Head aged 33, Catherine Williams, wife aged 39, **Martha Ann Watkins, adopted daughter**, aged 4 born Llanelly, David Evans, Boarder aged 23.

1891 Wales Census living at 14 Plantation Row, Ebbw Vale

John Williams, Head aged 43, fireman, Catherine Williams, wife aged 49, **Martha Ann Watkins, adopted daughter aged 14**, Albert Edward Hughes, boarder aged 16, William George Oakley, boarder aged 40, Richard JNO Roberts, boarder aged 15, Henry Passmore, father-in-law aged 77.

1898 MARRIAGE RECORD Ebbw Vale Parish.

30th July Christopher John Jones of 21 Eureka Place, aged 27, Bachelor, employed as a clerk, father Thomas Jones, foreman fitter married Martha Ann Watkins of 14 Plantation Row, Ebbw Vale, aged 21, spinster, father was Philip Watkins, builder.

1901 Wales Census living in Ebbw Vale

Christopher Jones, Head aged 30, Clerk, Martha Ann Jones, wife aged 34, Laura Jones, daughter aged 2, Gladys Jones, daughter aged 2 (believed 2 months)

1905 DEATH RECORDS Llanelly Parish Records [Bedwellty Apr May Jun Vol 11a Page 78]

7th June Christopher Jones died aged 34 and was buried at St Elli Church on the 10th.

1911 Wales Census living 14 Plantation Row, Ebbw Vale

Martha Anne Jones, Head, widow aged 34, Office cleaner, Laura E Jones, daughter aged 12, Gladys Jane Jones, daughter aged 10, Thomas John Jones, son aged 8

1921 Wales Census living at 45 Eureka Place Ebbw Vale

Martha Ann Jones, Head, widow aged 44 years 4 months, Gladys Jones, daughter aged 20 years 5 months

1947 DEATH RECORDS Llanelly Parish Records {Bedwellty Jan Feb Mar Vol 8c Page 119}

8th January Martha Ann Jones of 45 Eureka Place died aged 69 and was buried at St Elli Church on the 11th.
