EDWARDS, Israel. ROGERS, Frances & William



Inscription:

In memory of
ISRAEL EDWARDS
late of Blaenavon
who suddenly departed this life
4th June 1870 aged 29.

*'In the morning it flourisheth and growth up, in
the evening it is cut down and withereth'*

In Loving Memory of FRANCES
the dear beloved wife of
WILLIAM ROGERS,
who died 29th January 1895 aged 73.

*'The lord gave and the Lord hath taken away,
blessed be the name of the Lord'*

Also of the above WILLIAM ROGERS, who died
February 24th, 1902, aged 75.

'Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord'

1840 BIRTH RECORD Parish of Llanelly

Birth of Israel Edwards, baptised 12th January, parents John Edwards and Fanny Edwards of Rhonas Road, Clydach

1841 Wales Census living in Clydach Iron works.

Israel Richards, head aged 55, John Edwards, aged 25, Frances Edwards, aged 25, Israel Edwards, aged 9 months, John Edwards aged 3 years.

1851 Wales Census living in Rhonas Road, Clydach

John Edwards, head, aged 36, Frances Edwards, wife, aged 32, Israel Edwards, son, aged 10, John Edwards, son, aged 14

1852 MARRIAGE RECORD {Crickhowell Jan Feb Mar Vol 11B Page 220}

Frances Edwards married William Rogers

1863 MARRIAGE RECORD {Glamorgan July Aug Sep Vol 11a Page 502}

Israel Edwards married Mary Jane Hughes

1861 Wales Census living at Rhonas Road, Clydach

William Rogers, head, aged 36, puddler in Iron Works, Frances Edwards, wife aged 41 and Jane Williams, boarder aged 17 years.

1861 Wales Census living in Parish of Hay

Israel Edwards, servant, wagoner aged 18. Head of household John Williams grand brewer

1870 DEATH RECORD Llanelly Parish Records {Crickhowell Apr May June 1870 Vol 11a Page 53}

4th of June Israel Edwards died aged 29 years and was buried at St Elli Church on the 06th. The death certificate details that the cause of death was pneumonia.

1871 Wales Census living in Llanelly Parish

William Rogers, aged 46, Baller in Iron works, Francis Rogers, wife aged 52 and Mary J F Rogers, granddaughter aged 6 years.

1881 Wales Census living in Church Road, Llanelly Parish

William Rogers, Head, aged 58 General Labourer, Francis Rogers, wife, aged 62 and M J Frances Rogers, daughter aged 16, dressmaker.

1891 Wales Census living in Church Road, Llanelly Parish

William Rodgers, Head, aged 66 General Labourer, Francis Rodgers, wife, aged 69 dressmaker. Recorded as speaking both Welsh and English.

1895 DEATH RECORD Llanelly Parish Records {Crickhowell Jan Feb Mar Vol 11b Page 90}

29th of January Frances Rogers died aged 73 and was buried at St Elli Church on the 01st of February.

1901 Wales Census living at the Rising Sun Public House, Clydach

Matthew Richards Head aged 41, Martha Richards, wife, aged 40, Trevor son aged 17, Elizabeth, daughter aged 16, Brindley, son aged 15, Winsor son aged 12, Martha Richards, daughter aged 9, Gertrude daughter aged 4 and **William Rogers aged 74, uncle.**

1902 DEATH RECORD Llanelly Parish Records William {Crickhowell Jan Feb Mar Vol 11b Page 92}

24th of February William Rogers died aged 75 and was buried at St Elli Church.

Additional Information:

Israel Edwards and Mary Jane Hughes married in 1863, Merthyr Tydfil. Baptism records show that they had a daughter Mary Jane Frances Edwards in 1864, she was baptised 10th June 1884 in Llanelly Parish. Her father is shown as Israel Edwards, occupation of puddler.

Mary Jane Frances Edwards married 1883, aged 19, spouse Thomas William. The certificate shows her father is Israel Edwards, occupation hammerman.
