1863 MARRIAGE RECORD Parish Church Llanelly

10th of March Daniel Lloyd, father Peter Lloyd married Gwenllian Morgan, father Morgan Morgan.

1871 Wales Census living Merthyr Road , Cheltenham Village between Old Royal Oak Public House and Clydach Arms {Cheltenham village now known as Clydach North, Abergavenny}

Daniel Lloyd Head aged 47 born Llangeitho, Cardiganshire, Tailor/Grocer, Gwenllian Lloyd, Wife aged 31, Cwm, Carmarthenshire, Mary A Lloyd, daughter aged 2 months and Mary Morgan aged 17 servant.

1881 Wales Census living at Turnpike Road, Llanelly Parish next to Clydach Arms Public House

David Lloyd, head aged 58, Grocer, Gwen Lloyd, wife aged 47, Mary Lewis, mother, widow aged 83, born Llanbadarn, Cardiganshire, recorded as blind for 10 years, Anne Davies, aged 12 visitor, Margaret Williams, servant aged 20 and Sarah Williams, aged 17 servant.

13th May Mary Lewis died aged 83 and was buried at St Eli Church on the 17th.

1891 Wales Census recorded as living Main Road in the parish of Llanelly

David Lloyd, head aged 67, Grocer, Gwenllian Lloyd, wife aged 55, Anne Morgan, niece aged 21 and Leah Evans, servant aged 14.

1901 Wales Census recorded as living Turnpike Road, Parish of Llanelly

David Lloyd, Head aged 75, Grocer, Gwen Lloyd, wife aged 64 Hilda Williams, niece and Leah Evans, Servant aged 25.

1st May Daniel Lloyd died aged 82 and was buried at St Elli Church on the 4th

Additional Information

Daniel Lloyd is detailed a Grocer, Clydach in the Slaters directory 1880

NB Details of the death of his wife Gwenllian Lloyd and his children are recorded on Grave No: F395.

It cannot be ascertained when Daniel's father died and when his mother remarried to obtain the surname Lewis.
