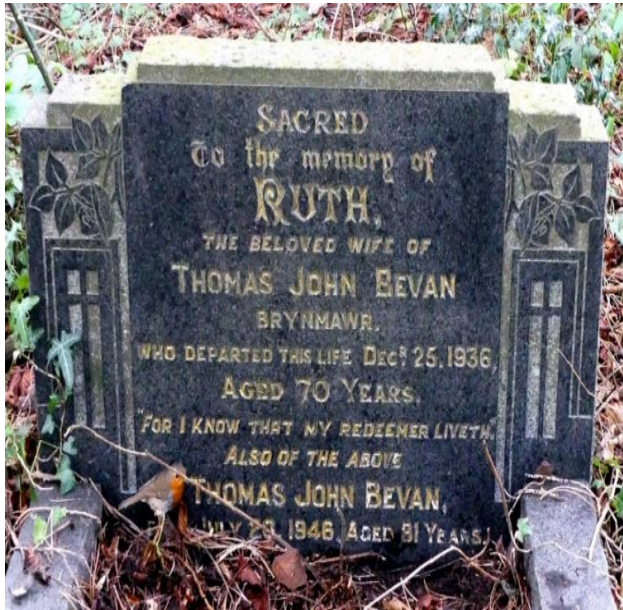

1886 Marriage record {Crickhowell Jul Aug Sept Volume 11B Page 145}

Thomas John Bevan married Ruth Fox

1891 Wales Census living at Gellyfellen, Llanelly Hill.

Thomas John Bevan was working as a miner and living with his wife Ruth aged 24 and daughter Elizabeth Ann aged 3. {F357}

1901 Wales Census living in Cwm Nant Gam

Thomas John Bevan aged 35, Ruth Bevan, aged 34, Elizabeth Bevan {F357} aged 13, Hannah

1911 Wales Census living at Cwm Nant Gam

Thomas John Bevan 45, coal miner, Ruth Bevan, aged 44, Hannah Jane, daughter aged 19
Married for 24 years and had 4 children, 2 still living.

1921 Wales Census living at 108 Worcester Street, Brynmawr

Thomas Bevan, head aged 56, Ruth Wife aged 55 and Gwynffyrdd Wall, aged 10, granddaughter {daughter of Elizabeth Wall nee Bevan F357}

1936 Death Record {Crickhowell Oct Nov Dec Volume 11b Page 101}

Ruth Bevan died aged 70 years and was buried at St Elli Church

1939 Census living in Brynmawr

Edward Wall, born 1888, Elizabeth Wall born 13th February 1888, {F357} Thomas F Bevan, born 14th July 1865, retired miner.

1946 DEATH RECORD

Thomas John Bevan of Avondale, Hatton Street, Brynmawr died aged 81 and was buried at St Elli Church on the 23rd July.
