### FIELDER, Edith, Gertrude, Mona & Ellen



#### *Inscription:*

In Loving Memory of  
EDITH.

Eldest daughter of the late  
JOHN NEVILLE FIELDER of Triley Court.  
Born August 25<sup>th</sup> 1838, died June 16<sup>th</sup> 1887.  
*'With Christ which is far better.'*

Also of GERTRUDE sister of the above,  
born August 10<sup>th</sup> 1845, died October 21<sup>st</sup> 1898.  
*'Till He comes.'*

Also of MONA, sister of the above,  
born February 13<sup>th</sup> 1841, died October 13<sup>th</sup> 1921.  
*'Until the day breaks.'*

Also of ELLEN, sister of the above,  
born April 2<sup>nd</sup> 1842, died March 15<sup>th</sup> 1922.  
*'Thy presence is fulness of joy.'*

John Neville Fielder, head, aged 40 born Surrey, Ellen Fielder, wife age 20, born Ireland and their children Edith aged 2, Cara aged 1, Mona aged 4 months

Birth of Gertrude who was baptised at Llantilio Pertholey Church on the 9<sup>th</sup> October, parents John Fielder, esquire and Ellen Fielder

#### **1851 Wales Census living at Triley Court, Monmouthshire**

John Fielder, head aged 50, Ellen, wife aged 30 and their seven daughters **Edith, aged 12**, Cara, aged 11, **Mona, aged 10**, **Ellen, aged 8**, Constance aged 7, **Gertrude aged 5** and Florence aged 3.  
All children were schooled at home, a governess and 4 servants are also listed on the census

#### **1861 Wales Census Living at Triley Court Monmouthshire**

John Fielder, head aged 60, Land proprietor and fund holder, Ellen Fielder, wife aged 40, fund holder, and their children **Edith, aged 22**, Cara, aged 21, Constance age 17, **Gertrude age 15**, Florence age 14 Trevor age 7. Several servants were also living with the family.  
It is not known where Mona and Ellen were living at this time.

1868 John Neville Fielder head of the household and father died aged 69.

### **1871 Wales Census Triley Court, Monmouthshire**

Ellen Fielder, head aged 50, landowner, and her children, **Edith aged 32**, Cara aged 31, **Mona aged 30**, **Ellen aged 29**, Constance aged 27, Gertrude **aged 25**, Florence aged 24 and Trevor aged 17.

No trace for Ellen Fielding

### **1881 Wales Census Dan Y Bont House, Gilwern.**

**Edith Fielder, head, aged 42**, annuitant, Cara aged 41, annuitant, **Mona aged 40, annuitant, Ellen aged 39**, annuitant, Constance Holland, visitor aged 37, wife of clergyman and her daughter Edith F Holland aged 2  
Constance is their sister as she married Rev Philip Holland

### **1881 England Census Vicarage, Coaley, Gloucestershire**

**Gertrude Fielder aged 38 visiting** her sister Constance Holland Family. Philip ES Holland his 8-month-old daughter Gertrude Holland.

### **1887 DEATH RECORD**

18<sup>th</sup> June Edith Fielder died and was buried at St Elli Church on the 20<sup>th</sup>.

### **1891 Wales Census Living at Dan y Bont House, Gilwern**

Cara Fielder, head aged 51, Mona Fielder aged 50, both living by their own means, 2 servants

Ellen Fielder aged 49 is staying with their brother Trevor and Family in London

Their mother Ellen Fielder aged 69, widow is now residing at the Priory, St Mary's Church, Abergavenny

### **1898 DEATH RECORD**

21<sup>st</sup> October Gertrude Fielder died at University College Hospital Middlesex and was buried St Elli Church on the 25<sup>th</sup>

### **1901 Wales Census Dan y Bont House, Gilwern**

Cara Fielder, head aged 61, Mona, aged 60, Ellen aged 58, servants also living with them

All living off their own means

### **1911 Wales Census Dan y Bont House, Gilwern**

Cara Fielder, head aged 71, Mona, aged 70, Ellen aged 69

All living off private means

### **1921 DEATH RECORD**

13<sup>th</sup> October Mona Fielder died and was buried at St Elli Church on the 17th of Oct 1921

Probate to Trevor Fielder {brother} and Philip Fielder Holland {brother-in-law} £2972

### **1922 DEATH RECORD**

15<sup>th</sup> March Ellen Fielder and was buried at St Elli Church on the 18th of March

Probate to Gertrude Theodora Holland Spinster {niece} £3808

### **Additional Information**

Dan y Bont House was their home for many years was advertised for sale in July 1922. This was a substantial dwelling with 7 bedrooms and stables.

Their parents John Neville Fielder, Gentleman and mother Ellen Fielder, Lady nee Callow married in Dorchester in 1837.

Shortly after their marriage they moved to Triley Court. Little is known about the history of their background but the history of Triley Court indicates that he purchased this in the early 1840's. However, John Fielder is recorded on the 1830 Pigot's Directory, Gentry and Clergymen section as living at Triley Court.
