#### **1827 BIRTH RECORD Brecon Tabernacle Chapel St Mary [Weslyan Records]**

4<sup>th</sup> June Howell Edmund baptised father Howell a labourer, mother Jane of Glanywern [Llanywern] Brecon.

#### **1834 BIRTH RECORD from the censii.**

Mary Morgan was born in the Parish of Llanfair ar y bryn [near Llandovery] Carmarthanshire.

#### **1851 Wales Census, living in Bryngare, [near Clydach Dingle] Llangattock.**

Howell Edmund aged 24 a collier with parents Howell aged 47 and Jane aged 54. Also with brother William 15 also a collier.

#### **1857 MARRIAGE RECORD Crickhowell June Aug Sept vol 11b page 176**

Howell Edmund marries Mary Morgan.

#### **1861 Wales Census living at Clydach Dingle, Brynmawr, Llanelly.**

Howell Edmund aged 33 years with wife Mary aged 26, living next door to his mother Jane aged 65, now a widow and his brother William aged 24, a collier.

#### **1871 Wales Census living in Clydach, Brynmawr, Llanelly.**

Howell Edmunds aged 44, a miner with wife Mary aged 37 and daughter aged 7 years, and living next door to his mother Jane a widow aged 74.

#### **1881 Wales Census living in Clydach Dingle, Brynmawr, Llanelly.**

Howell Edmunds aged 54 a coal miner but sick and unable to work of Glanywern, with wife Mary aged 47 of Llanfairarybryn and daughter Mary Ann age 16 years of Llanelly.

#### **1882 DEATH RECORDS St Elli [Llanelly Parish Church].**

11<sup>th</sup> March Mary Edmunds dies and is buried on the 15<sup>th</sup>

31<sup>st</sup> March Howell Edmunds dies and is buried on the 5<sup>th</sup> of April.
