1861 Wales Census living in Wain Lapra, Llanelly Hill

James Arthur Powell born 1858 aged 3 years living with parents John Powell aged 32 years, a Coal Miner of Llanelly and Jane nee Roberts aged 28 years of Gnosall, Wolverhampton, Staffordshire.

1881 Wales Census living in Coed Cai, Wain Lapra, Llanelly Hill.

James A Powell, aged 23 years, a Coal Miner living with parents John and Jane and family.

1883 MARRIAGE RECORD, {Crickhowell Apr May Jun, Vol 11b Page 198}

Possible marriage to Alice Jones of Blaenavon.

1891 Wales Census living in the 'Slopes', Gellifelen, Llanelly.

James Powell aged 34 years a Coal Miner with wife Alice aged 27 years and sons Abraham, William and John.

1895 BIRTH & 1897 DEATH RECORDS, Llanelly Church. Curate D M Jones.

David Powell born January 30th 1895 and died February 9th 1897, buried on the 15th.

1901 Census of Wales. Living at Mount Pleasant, Llanelly.

James Powell aged 44 years, a Coal Miner with wife Alice aged 35 years with family including Abraham, William and John.

1904 DEATH RECORD. Llanelly Church, Curate W T Brian.

May 3rd death of Alice Powell aged 41 years buried on the 5th.

1911 Census of Wales. Living at Mount Pleasant, Llanelly Hill.

James Powell aged 53 years, a Coal Miner now a Widower. He states he would have been married for 28 years [1883], had 8 children 2 of which have died.

1927 DEATH RECORD. Llanelly Church. Curate T W B Thomas.

October 6th Death of James Arthur Powell aged 69 years of Mount Pleasant buried on the 11th.
